






BRICK & BLOCKLAYING APPRENTICESHIP READY COURSE



FIVE-DAY SHORT COURSE

This five-day short course will provide students with a taste of the Bricklaying industry, as well as an opportunity to obtain a White Card.

Students will complete three-days of workshop training where they will obtain a White Card whilst learning about basic hand skills, how to mix mortar, how to handle a trowel and lay bricks and how to identify and use bricklaying tools and equipment. They will also complete two-days of on-the-job work experience.

Successfully completion of the course may lead to further apprenticeship studies in brick/blocklaying.

This course is aligned with the Australian Brick and Block Laying Training Foundation.

Entrance requirements

To be eligible for a Western Australian apprenticeship you must be either

- an Australian citizen or have Australian citizenship
- be a permanent resident
- be the holder of a passport with Visa subclass 309, 310, 820, 826, 851; or
- be a dependant on a 457 Visa.

You MUST provide proof of your status at your first class, by showing either your Australian passport, Australian Citizenship Certificate, Australian Birth Certificate, Overseas Passport with Permanent Residency Visa or Visa subclass, Medicare Card, Commonwealth Health Care Card or Commonwealth Seniors Health Card.
